- To maintain discipline among students in the University is also a responsibility of the Dean, Students Welfare.

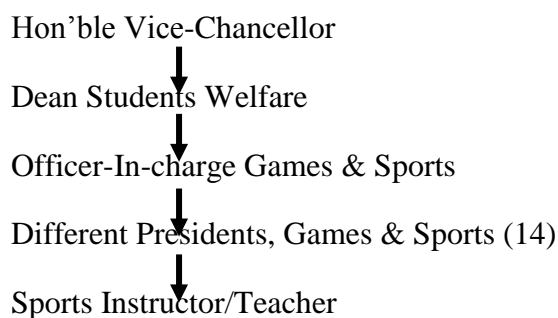
