278:1613: To consider and approve the special provisions and procedures for conducting various examinations and related activities for completing the degree requirements of the final year undergraduate and final year postgraduate students in the 2nd Semester, 2019-20 in view of unavoidable circumstances caused by absence of students from campuses due to prevailing Covid-19 pandemic as recommended in the meetings of Deans & Directors of the University held under chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor on 23.06.2020 and 04.07.2020 as well as requests made by Deans of different Colleges.

The agenda was discussed in detail and after thorough discussion following decisions were made and unanimously approved.

- The mid-term, practical and final examinations of courses of final year (IVth year) Under Graduate and final year (IInd year) Post Graduate degree programmes will be conducted using on-line systems.
- 2. The question paper for online mid-term examination of U.G. and P.G. courses will have eighty (80) objective questions comprising 20 questions each of four types or sections, namely, (A) Multiple Choice, (B) Fill in the Blanks (C) True or False, and (D) Matching type. The student can attempt all the questions. However, best fifteen (15) questions each from each type or section A,B,C,D will be considered for marking to complete a total of sixty questions in 75.0 minutes (1.15 hour). Each objective question will be of 0.5 (1/2) mark so that the 60 questions considered will complete 30.0 maximum marks allotted for mid-term examination of a course.
- 3. The on-line practical examination of U.G. and P.G. courses will be conducted by allotting 10 marks for on-line viva-voice and 10 marks for on-line short answer questions/assignment to make a total of 20.0 marks allotted for practical examination of courses comprising theory as well as practical. In case of courses having only practical without any theory, the practical examination will be conducted by allotting 50 marks for on-line viva-voice and 50 marks for on-line short answer questions/assignment to make a total of 100 marks allotted for practical examination of courses comprising only practical.
- 4. The question paper for on-line final examination of the courses of the final year (IVth year) Under Graduate and final year (IInd year) Post Graduate degree programmes will have one hundred twenty (120) objective questions comprising 30 questions each of four types or sections, namely, (A) Multiple Choice, (B) Fill in the Blanks (C) True or False and (D) Matching type. The student can attempt all the 120 questions. However, best twenty- five (25) questions each from each type or section A,B,C,D will be considered for marking to complete a total of hundred (100) questions in 120.0 minutes (2.00 hours). Each objective question will be of 0.5 (1/2) mark so that the 100 questions considered will complete 50.0 maximum marks allotted for final examination of a course.
- 5. All the question papers for the on-line mid-term, practical and final examinations of all the Under Graduate and Post Graduate courses will be set by internal examiners. No honorarium or payment will be to internal paper setters.

- 6. The question papers of final examination set by internal examiners will be subjected to moderation by a panel of teachers deputed for respective colleges as per approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.
- 7. All the required examinations of all the training type courses like RAWE, ELP, Internship and industrial training etc. will be conducted on-line as per requirements/ mandates of the respective courses. The required reports shall be submitted on-line by the students followed by on-line conduct of vivavoice conducted by the mandated committee.
- 8. The written comprehensive examination of Post Graduate students will be conducted on-line by sending the question papers of major and minor courses to obtain the on-line returns of written answers which will be evaluated after downloading and printing.
- 9. The oral comprehensive examination, thesis seminars and thesis viva voice examinations of Post Graduate & Ph.D. students will also be conducted online via video-conferencing attended by the advisory committee and/ or external examiner as per mandate.
- 10. One hard copy and one soft copy of the thesis manuscript of Post Graduate and Ph.D. students signed by student & advisor will be submitted to Registrar Office through Dean of College & Dean, PGS. The soft copy of manuscript may be sent on-line to external examiner(s) for evaluation. The examined/corrected thesis manuscript and signed evaluation report will be obtained from the examiner on-line. After incorporation of corrections/ improvements/modifications suggested by the examiner(s), the thesis manuscript will be examined / reviewed by the Advisory Committee for recommendation for conduct of thesis viva-voice examination in collaboration of external examiner and virtual viva-voice will be conducted. The certificate for satisfactory completion of thesis viva-voce examination signed by external examiner will be obtained for attaching in the hard copies of the thesis manuscript for final submission.
- 11. The IInd semester 2019-20 will be extended till further notice instead of 30th June 2020 as outlined in the existing Academic Calendar of the semester.
- 12. It was also resolved that the provisions procedures of on-line mid-term, practical and final examinations approved above for final year U.G. & P.G. students may followed later for other batches/years of respective programmes if needed in future due to prevailing covid-19 pandemic.
