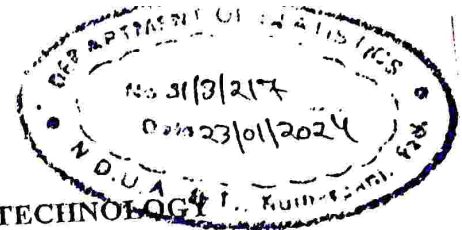



The Council has thoroughly discussed the matter and decided that at least two research papers published in Scopus Indexed journal/Journal with NAAS rating above 06, will be mandatory. If the NAAS rating of the journal is below 07, the number of co-authors of the paper should be only 03. For faculty in colleges/departments where PG & Ph.D. degree programme is/are not been conducted, at least 03 publications will be mandatory. Faculty members/scientists who has patent /technology/variety/review paper published in journal/s with NAAS rating 08 and above, will be exempted from the mandatory criteria of at least two research papers published in Scopus Indexed journal for the increment. All research papers should be submitted only through university email I.D. (nduat.org).


