- Till date the university has conducted 12 meeting of IQAC and the proceedings have been uploaded on the university website.
- NAAC Criteria wise development is assessed under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.
- The progress is reviewed time to time and action taken report is prepared accordingly and uploaded on university website.
- The feedback obtained from the filled feedback forms are reviewed and suggestions pointed out are addressed.
- As discussed in IQAC meetings following initiatives have been taken to enhance the quality of teaching , learning research and governance
  - Time frame of different activities decided. Academic calendar of all the colleges prepared.
  - Feed back forms of students, alumini, faculty and employers have been generated and circulated .
  - Skill development programs have been initiated by the Directorate of Training and placement
  - Research programs have been developed taking into consideration the local needs.
  - University is making efforts to enter into MoU's with different institutes of repute.
