ANALYSIS OF STUDENT FEEDBACK FORM

The feedback form was received from 562 students on 19 criteria. Analysis of Google sheets revealed that 92.2% of the respondents were comfortable with the duration of the program to cover the course syllabus. 92.2% of the respondents strongly agreed with provision of selecting elective/ minor/ supporting courses in the course curriculum. 83.4 % respondents expressed willingness for provision of value added course apart from course curriculum. Merely 6.6% respondents said that opportunities for developing skills in the curriculum are poor. Rest 93.4% students were satisfied with opportunities of skill development in the course curriculum. 97.5% students were happy with the quality of the curriculum.

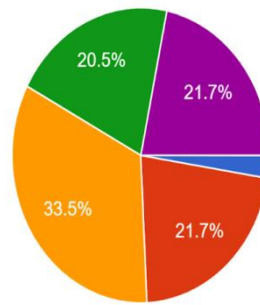

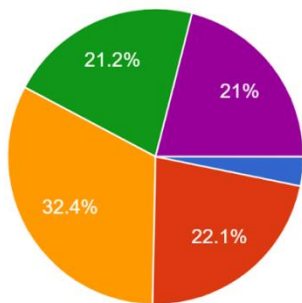

Quality of the curriculum



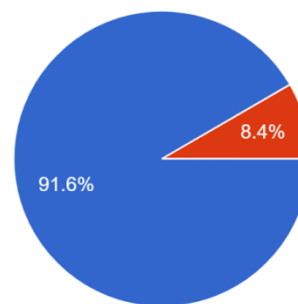







S.No.	Suggestions	Action Taken

2	Placement cell should be more active so that maximum number of students can be selected.	Placement cell has been strengthened and placement drive is being conducted more pro-actively.

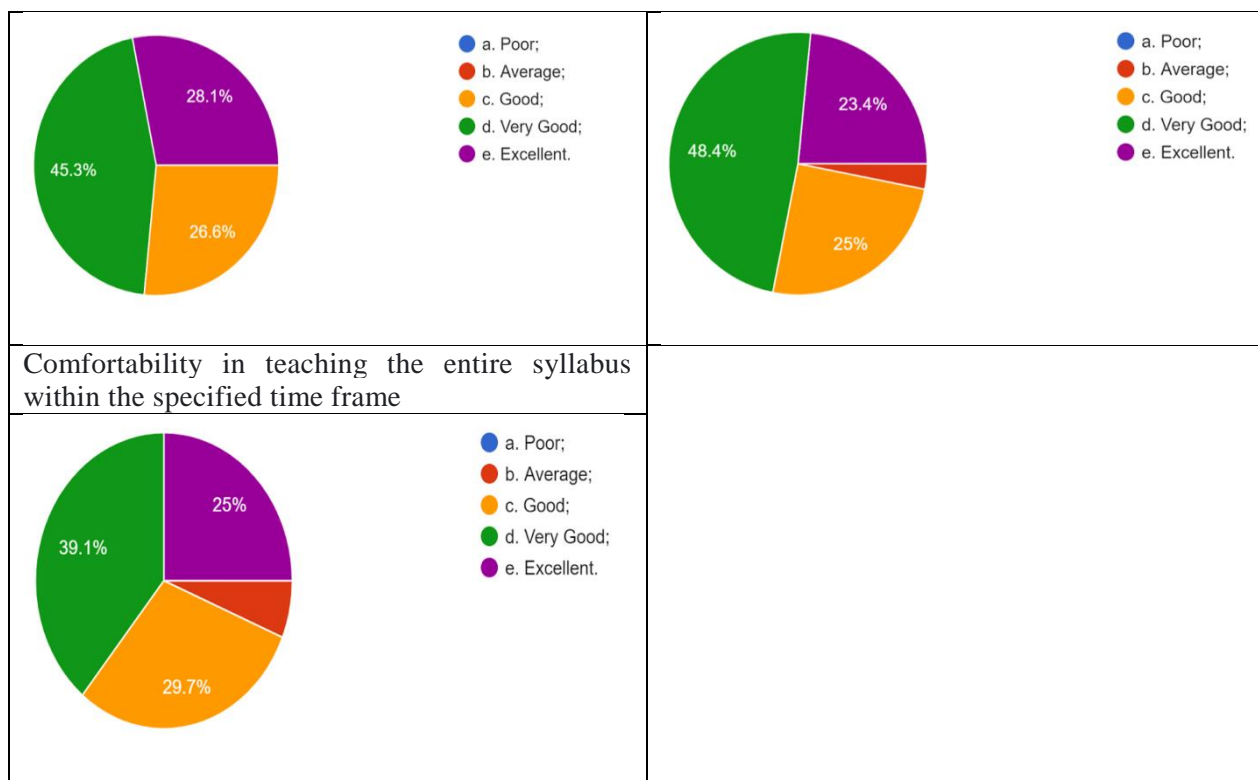
3	Modernisation of M.Sc. Ph.D. class room	Smart classroom facilities have been created in all the colleges.

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TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

Teachers feedback form was designed to gather information regarding their view on adequacy of the curriculum, opportunity for developing skills in the curriculum, availability of instructional hours, easy availability of study materials, relevance of the course for providing employability, worth of syllabus in catering to the needs of industry/society, provision of inculcating students' creativity in the curriculum, comfortability in teaching the entire syllabus within the specified time frame. A total of 153 responses were received.


Comfortability in teaching the entire syllabus within the specified time frame

The analysis of the teacher's feedback forms revealed that curriculum is adequate enough in providing in-depth knowledge with opportunity for developing skills, employability. The syllabus is very much helpful in catering to the needs of industry/society. All the teachers were of opinion that the curriculum is helpful in inculcating creativity among students'. They were satisfied with the instructional hours and the study material availability.
